- Identify and develop the talents of students in individual, dual, and team physical activities and sports.
- Enforce standards of safety behavior to ensure a productive learning environment.
- Communicate concerns about student conduct with parents and school administration.
- Participate in staff meetings and school-sponsored events relevant to the P.E. program.
- Ensure the optimal condition and safety of all physical education equipment.

- Bachelor's degree in physical education, kinesiology, exercise science, or a related discipline.
